The First Nations House of Learning logo was created by Tsimshian artist Glen Wood. It consists of a human face surrounded by two ravens which also form the frame of a longhouse. The face represents First Nations people. The house design represents the university, or “House of Learning”, which is the way some Aboriginal languages refer to schools. The Raven, a symbol of creativity and learning, is also known as a trickster or transformer in many First Nations cultures. As represented here, Raven is transforming the university to reflect First Nations cultures and philosophies, linking the university to First Nations cultures.
